
1. Bees

2. beeswax



Esters of fatty acids and fatty alcohols, i. e. compounds whose molecules contain long-chain alkyl residues.

The wax platelets sweated out of the wax glands by the honey bees originally have a white colour. The yellow colour is caused by the absorption of an ingredient of the flower pollen, the pollen oil, which in turn contains the natural dye carotene.

3. Evaluation by the Consumer Center NRW

If you make bee waxes yourself, you should . . .

- ✓ . . . if possible, use GOTS certified, uncolored and unprinted organic cotton and wash it before.
- ✓ . . . use 100% pure beeswax from organic farming in food quality.
- ✓ . . . do not add jojoba oil. In fact, jojoba oil is a wax which accumulated in feeding experiments in the intestinal cells of animals and led to cell destruction.
- ✓ . . . do not use mineral oil-based waxes (e. g. paraffin candle remnants) to make the wipes.

How to make beeswax food wraps for a plastic free kitchen

Supplies Needed:

- **Beeswax** Cosmetic-grade beeswax
- **pitch scissors**
- **parchment paper /** baking sheets
- **iron/ ironing board**
- **a piece of 100% cotton fabric**
- **cardboard as a backing**
- **brush**
